The Cornell Road Sustainability Coalition

The Cornell Road Sustainability Coalition (CRSC) is a partnership of neighborhood associations and interested parties working to define and recommend a strategy to remedy the negative effects of excessive commuter traffic along the Cornell corridor – used as an alternate route to US26 (Sunset Highway).

CRSC seeks to build consensus and understanding about the importance of preserving adjacent neighborhoods

and the assets of Forest Park sanctuaries. CRSC's goal is to aid in resource management by promoting balanced usage for pedestrians, bicyclists, tourists, joggers, students, nature park enthusiasts and the Forest Park ecosystem. Implicit in this goal is the need to improve safety.

CRSC believes access needs to be managed to maximize the utility and lifespan of the underlying resource. The infrastructure of NW Cornell pre-dates modern traffic construction and management techniques and these roads survive today as they did in the early 20th century. Any improvements recommended by CRSC will be a starting point for continued modern management as the urban center grows.




