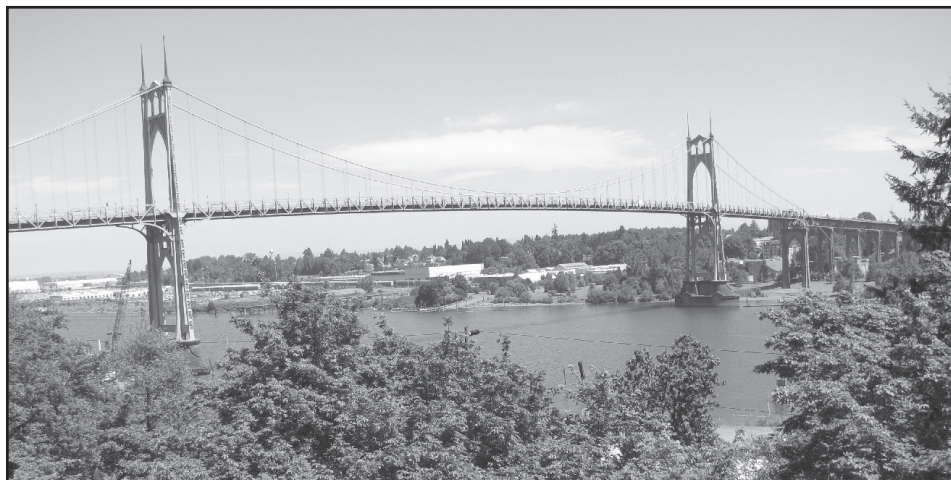

The Pearl Talks -- Livability Committee Update

The Pearl District's Livability Committee (the Committee) was reactivated in mid-October. The Committee focuses on day-to-day living issues, such as distributing "Mutt Mitts," overseeing trash disposal (the City does not pick up trash in the Pearl), obtaining more trash cans as growth continues, and interacting with NET, the Neighborhood Emergency Team.

Other activities have included "Polish the Pearl" – our spring and fall clean-ups – and working with the City to create a "Quiet Zone" around the railroad crossings.

This year the Committee will focus on community involvement, advocate for the Central Portland Families organization, Kids in the Pearl, Isobel's Clubhouse, and partner with local merchants on family friendly activities.

Some event ideas include a community "yard sale," a movie night, and get-togethers at local restaurants where residents can mingle. The first Pearl District restaurant to volunteer to host an event is Sweet Masterpiece (922 NW Davis Street). The Committee is also considering interactive

events such as treasure hunts and a rewards program.

The Livability Committee is taking the "blue sky" approach to our activities this year. Let us know what we can do better. And please, if you have ideas, let's hear 'em!
