Elk or Executive Homes What future do we want for the West Hills?

elk in the West Hills, only 15 minutes from downtown?

In the same area, next to the Urban Growth Boundary, organic farmer Greg Malinowski grows vegetables and beef for local stores. He leases land to MercyCorps so immigrants can grow food for farmer's markets. When a nearby school started a Community Supported Agriculture farm, Greg plowed their field for free.

Multnomah County has an opportunity to put farms, natural resources, and areas important to our "sense of place" into Rural Reserves, protecting them from urban development for 40 years.

But County Commissioners don't propose to protect the elk or Greg's farm.

The County's Citizen Advisory Committee recommended protecting all of the West Hills within Rural

Did you know that there are up to 50 Reserves. The Planning Commission, four neighborhoods, and Forest Park Conservancy agree.

> But the County Commission apparently supports a lobbyist proposal to develop subdivisions on 500 acres of elk habitat and farms (including Greg's) and to build more executive homes off Skyline Blvd. Fees intended to build local parks in the subdivisions would instead be used to create a park around the new executive homes.

> There's a county hearing at 10:30 a.m. on December 10. Share your opinion.
