NWDA Street Clean-up

On June 28th, NWDA volunteers covered nearly 100 neighborhood blocks at its annual street clean up. Approximately a half ton of trash was collected during the two hour event. Sixteen pounds of mixed recyclables were also gathered, along with a shopping cart, two carpet rolls, and 90 pounds of scrap metal.

The area of highest trash concentration was under the 405 freeway. Other areas that produced high levels of trash were apartment buildings and certain bars & convenience stores along 21st and 23rd Avenues.

Juliet Hyams, NWDA President, joined the effort. "A lot of the trash we picked up can be traced directly to specific businesses," said Hyams. "I encourage local businesses to watch where their patrons throw their trash, and

to stop using disposable cups, utensils and food containers. It will improve our neighborhood for residents and visitors alike."

Alison Wallisch of NWNW provided logistical support, SOLV provided trash bags, and Legacy Good Sam disposed of all the trash after the event. Lucky Lab provided the meeting space and Food Front continued its support of neighborhood clean up projects.

Additional support came from Pizza Schmizza, Noah's Bagels, World Cup, Café Mingo, Basta's, Stella's, Trader Joe's, and Bishop's.
